



## Completers' Employment Data

### Description:

The Exchange is Marian University's career and placement service. Staff in that office survey and track all university completers after program completion. Completers are asked to indicate if they have secured full-time employment or are continuing their education to a higher level. This data is reported annually and includes completers from the academic year (Summer, Fall, and Spring semesters).

### Analysis:

- As a whole, EPP completers exceed the university's overall average for full-time employment and continuing education (82% compared to 80%).
- Elementary education majors are the largest group of completers and they have an 84% rate of employment or continuing to graduate studies.

- Completers in Applied Educational Studies have the lowest percentage of employment or continuing education, but the sample size is very small.

**Interpretation:**

There are strong rates of employment and continuing education, but there are a number of students who remain unaccounted for because they have not responded to the surveys from The Exchange.

**Action:**

As candidates near completion, the important of responding to outreach from The Exchange should be emphasized to candidates.
